

Outside Fine Arts Participation



DSST: Byers High School requires all students to participate in three (3) trimesters of fine arts over their four years in high school in order to fulfill the Fine Arts graduation requirement.

Students may fulfill this requirement by participating in:

- a DSST: Byers High School fine arts elective
- a DSST: Byers High School fine arts club
- a CHSAA sanctioned Fine Art
- a physical activity not offered at DSST that is approved by the Electives Director.

This form must be completed, returned to DSST: Byers Electives Coordinator Mike Lang, and approved in order for outside activities to go towards graduation credit. We require you to complete this process *after* participating in an activity to ensure credit.
